

Environmental Code

Blue Seven is committed to the responsible use of the environment and natural resources as part of its business activities. The purpose of this policy is the systematic integration of environmental aspects into relevant corporate processes as well as parts of the supply chain.

The company takes into account applicable environmental legal requirements at national, European, and international levels and is guided by recognized environmental and sustainability standards.

1. Legal Requirements and Due Diligence Obligations

Blue Seven complies with all applicable environmental laws and regulatory requirements of the Federal Republic of Germany as well as the European Union.

In addition, environmental aspects are incorporated into decision-making and procurement processes within the scope of operational possibilities.

At the level of direct suppliers (Tier 1), compliance with applicable national environmental regulations is expected. In addition, internationally recognized environmental standards and voluntary industry initiatives may be taken into account.

2. Resource Efficiency

Blue Seven aims to use energy, water, and materials efficiently.

This includes in particular:

- reduction of waste in operational activities
- optimization of material usage
- promotion of efficient energy consumption
- consideration of resource-efficient process design

Measures are continuously reviewed and adjusted within organizational and technical possibilities.

3. Waste Management and Circular Approaches

The company generally supports approaches to waste prevention, reuse, and recycling.

Within internal processes, employees are made aware of the importance of responsible resource use.

Measures to promote circular economy approaches are implemented step by step, insofar as this is operationally feasible.

4. Energy Consumption and Renewable Energy

The energy supply at the Oberstaufen site consists, according to the provider, of electricity from renewable energy sources.

In addition, a photovoltaic system (solar installation) is operated at the site for partial self-generation of electricity. The electricity generated is used on site for operational purposes and helps reduce externally sourced energy demand.

For heating systems, energy from biomass-based supply solutions is partially used.

5. Water Management

Water is recognized as a natural resource and is used responsibly within operational activities.

Since no production processes take place at the site, water consumption is mainly limited to office and sanitary use.

In the supply chain, water-related risks may be considered using external assessment tools (e.g., amfori BEPI).

6. Greenhouse Gas Emissions and Climate Risks

Blue Seven strives to take direct and indirect environmental impacts of its business activities into account.

Relevant emission sources may be found in particular in the supply chain as well as in transport and logistics processes.

The company works to identify environmental and climate risks within its sphere of influence and to assess appropriate improvement measures.

7. Supply Chain Cooperation

Blue Seven works with suppliers and relevant stakeholders to address environmental aspects in the supply chain.

Recognized external tools and standards (e.g., amfori BEPI, Higg Index, or GOTS-related requirements) may be used in a supporting role.

Certifications are used as a guiding framework and implemented within available processes.

8. Continuous Improvement

The environmental performance of the company is regularly reviewed and further developed within organizational possibilities.

The aim is the gradual improvement of relevant environmental indicators and processes, taking into account economic and operational conditions.

9. Communication and Transparency

Blue Seven promotes internal and external exchange on environmental and sustainability topics.

Information on environmental measures is provided within the scope of existing reporting obligations or internal communication processes.

This environmental policy is reviewed regularly and adjusted if necessary. It complements existing policies on compliance, supply chain management, and sustainability.
